

TRAINING REPORT – 2020 DTA Conference

This has been a difficult year to try to provide training. At the beginning of the year, I set up classes to be held throughout the year, but most of them had to be cancelled due to the pandemic. We have held a couple of small classes: one PASS Class at Aberdeen with 5 attendees, and one PASS, PASS Recert, and Defensive Driving Class at Dickinson with 8 attendees. My hope is that we may be able to reschedule at least some of the previously planned classes before the end of the year. The December class at Aberdeen is still on the schedule. **Please watch the tidbits and web site for any updates.** Driver recertification is required every 2 years.

CTA is requiring trainers to take an online class to be able to do the new 7.0 PASS training. They provide only electronic versions of the trainee books and all correspondence between trainers and main office is done electronically. Since DTA had 70 of the defunct 6.0 versions, CTA agreed to replace them with the electronic 7.0 at no cost which is a real bonus for us. The new class is very good and covers a lot of the maltreatment awareness class so the board has voted to stop providing that class. We will continue to offer PASS, PASS Recertification and Defensive Driving Classes.
